Dah Karik: The process of wine making

Wine making is an integral part of the Kalasha socio-cultural life for spiritual as well as recreational purposes. Wine is normally made in most households during times of grape harvest and is kept stored mostly for consumption during festivals. Both males and females participate in the process and the Kalasha community of Bumburet, Birir, and Rumbur valleys are all involved.
